Dear Neighbor:

You are receiving this letter because you are a landowner that may potentially be affected by a pipeline project being considered in your area.

T. W. Phillips Pipeline Corp. ("T. W. Phillips"), based in western Pennsylvania plans to seek federal approval to build a new natural gas pipeline in your area. This pipeline will extend from a new ethanol production facility being constructed in the Borough of Clearfield to an interconnect with an existing Columbia Gas Transmission pipeline located approximately eight miles southeast of Clearfield in Boggs Township. The proposed route is detailed on the attached map. The tentative pipeline route may involve your property.

This proposed project, called the Bionol Pipeline Project, is an eight-mile, six-inch, underground coated steel pipeline. In order to design a pipeline route that balances the needs of the landowners, the impact to the environment, and the construction requirements, T. W. Phillips respectively requests that you permit professional surveyors onto your property to gather data and perform environmental and cultural studies.

You will soon be contacted by a T.W. Phillips representative to request permission and discuss the required surveys and studies to be conducted on your property. It is anticipated the survey and studies will begin in May. The survey and studies will help determine the specific route of the proposed project and identify areas of environmental, cultural, or historic importance.

This pipeline will be regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC"). We anticipate submitting an application to the FERC in the fall of 2008 and construction of the pipeline is expected to commence in the spring of 2009.

We plan to hold an open house meeting in the area in the near future to explain and provide additional information regarding the proposed project. You will be notified of the time and place of the meeting. In the meantime, if you have any questions you may contact Beverly Wogan, Administrative Assistant for Paul W.
