Agency Meetings

No agency meetings occurred in August.

The scoping period for FERC's Notice of Intent ("NOI") closed on August 25, 2008. FERC received letters from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, the United States Department of Interior Fish and Wildlife Service, and Pennsylvania American Water.

Stakeholder Communications

JJ Powell, Inc., a landowner near the terminus of the pipeline at the Bionol Plant, provided TWP with a site drawing of a planned mini-mart/gasoline station on their property. There is insufficient space to locate the pipeline on this property within the planned facilities; therefore, TWP will revise the pipeline route to use the road right-of-way around the JJ Powell, Inc. property.

Surveys

A Timber Rattlesnake habitat assessment was completed by Wetlands Habitat Management, Inc. A report will be issued in early September.

A survey for the Indiana Bat using the USFWS Mist Netting Guidelines was completed by Environmental Solutions and Innovations, Inc. A report was sent to USFWS on August 20, 2008. The USFWS response will be submitted to the FERC when it becomes available.

Environmental Solutions and Innovations, Inc. commenced a survey for the Allegheny Plum on August 27, 2008. A report will be issued in September.

Cultural Resources field work was completed in July. Phase 1 Report will be issued in early September.

Resource Reports

Drafts of Resource Reports 2-9 and 11-13 were filed with the FERC on August 1, 2008.

Open Season

The Open Season concluded on June 20, 2008. TWP is evaluating a potential shipper's expressed interest.

Upcoming for September

TWP will file second drafts of Resource Reports 2, 6, and 8, its responses to the FERC's

Informal Data Requests, and a draft Environmental Assessment Report with the FERC.

TWP will file its Timber Rattlesnake habitat assessment report with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.

TWP will file its Allegheny Plum survey report with the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

TWP will file its Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan with the Clearfield County Conservation District.

TWP will file its application for a General Permit with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.
